1. What we do: Youth Teams will be out and about in different locations of Willenhall across the week to engage with young people. Youth staff will attend locations where young people may hang out. Youth Workers deliver a range of different projects that enable young people to experience new things. Outreach youth work allows young people to access youth service at places where they normally do not have access to youth centres or services. Workers will signpost young people to local activities that they can get involved in when they are not engaged in any other positive activity

2. What we do: Open access Breakfast youth Club which incorporates youth centre activities including Xbox, Play-station, Pool, Table Tennis, Art & crafts also with specialist Sports sessions. Do not worry if sports are not your favourite hobby because the youth activities are still on throughout the session. The youth club uses consultations and discussions with the young people so that staff can organise activities into a six week programme which meet the needs of the young people.

The Beechdale youth club is situated inside the Lifelong Centre. This is Located in the middle of the Beechdale Estate opposite Stephenson Square. The Youth Club has two separate rooms one used as the main youth activity room and the other the sports hall. The Youth Club room has sofas for relating as well as chairs and tables for completing project work; it has youth club equipment such as Pool table, Table Tennis, Graffiti Board, Xbox, Play-station, DVD Player, TV and music system that can be used. The young people have use of a fully functional kitchen when doing cooking activities and has a Tuck Shop where profits are put back in to the youth club. The Sports hall is used for various sports & recreational activities, Such as dance, football, badminton, cricket & fitness sessions.

How: Young people aged 9 to 19 years old are welcome to attend the youth club at any time. A parental consent form is required for all young people attending the youth club.

3. What we do: This youth session allows young people to have fun, make new friends, take part in activities and learn new skills. Young people are able to choose from array of activities including pool, cooking, computers, music, outdoor activities and arts and crafts. Sessions will also look at more structured activities, such as sexual health, drug awareness, condom distribution these are based on the needs of the young people attending. At times we will bring in outside experts to run sessions such as graffiti art and circus skills.

Dudley Fields Youth Centre is situated on Sneyd Hall Road on Dudley Fields. You will find the youth club located on the large green between the two sets of shops. The centre has two main areas, the youth club room. The youth club room has equipment including pool table, table football, television, Xbox, and sofas for relating. The centre has a computer station with internet access, these can be used for homework, project based work, CV building, surf the internet and play games. The centre also has a fully functional kitchen which is used when completing cooking activities and young person led Tuck Shop where profits are being put back in to the youth club. At the rear of the building there is a small area to relax in the summer and where young people and staff do projects such as gardening and sporting activities.

Kicsters is a digital pop-up youth club that trains and supports young people aged 8 – 18 to build resilience and supports them to dealing with a variety of issues that they may face.

We deliver a diverse range of digital based activities including radio production, photography, videography and animation. Other activities feature our innovative technology including our digital graffiti wall and photo/video/survey booth.

The 'KICSTERS' project empowers young people to meet regularly to train and develop their editing skills which they then use to interview their peers, parents and members of the community to gather information that can later be used to inform partners. In addition, young people are encouraged to talk about the issues they may face as well as become peer mentors, share stories and support one another. We also have links to professional mental health support and counselling services.

KIC is also a registered provider for Open College Network. This enables us to create our own accredited awards of which young people can work towards as part of the 'KICSTERS' project.
