As a childcare professional you want to offer as high a standard of care as possible. To help you do this, Walsall Families Information Service offers training and access to qualifications. Some of the training is mandatory and is the minimum level that a setting needs to ensure that your Ofsted grading isn't affected. A setting must have:

- **Paediatric First Aid**
At least 2 practitioners in every group care setting
All childminders
- **CIEH Food Safety**
All childcare workers
- **Safeguarding:**
Level 1 - All practitioners
Level 2 - 2 practitioners in every group care setting
- **Full and relevant Level 2 qualification**
50% of all other staff in group settings
- **Full and relevant Level 3 qualification**
All supervisors and managers in group settings

Some settings must also have:

CIEH Level 2 in Food Safety in catering

Aims & Objectives:

This course covers the basic principles of food hygiene which is both **Ofsted** and **Environmental Health** approved. This course is for all food handlers, with emphasis on all types of childcares' and their environment. You will be able to understand and maintain good practice in the handling, processing and preparation of safe food.
